### Make a call

- 1. Enter the number.
- 2. Press the Call or the Off-hook key (3). The system displays the number while dialing.
- 3. To erase the number, press Clear
- 4. To add or delete the digits from the middle of a number, use the navigation key (10).

## Answer a call

 Press the Off-hook Button or the Accept soft key. The name or number of the calling party is displayed if calling line information is available.

## Transfer a call

- Press the R softkey (2) The telephone system automatically places the current call on hold.
- 2. and dial the extension that you want to transfer to.
- 3. When connected, press the On Hook key (9).
- 4. If a transferred call is not answered, press R to return the caller.

## Put a call on hold

- 1. On an active call, press the R softkey (on the right) and then press 9. on hook key.
- To take call off hold press the 3. off hook key followed by R again.

### Access and listen to voicemail

From the dialog window, press Call to check the voicemail.

 If you select Close, the voicemail can be dialed by long pressing the 1 key in standby mode.
