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## Microsoft will be ending support for Windows 10 on October 14<sup>th</sup> 2025

Microsoft will no longer provide software updates, technical assistance or security fixes for your Windows 10.

### How will this affect you?

**Compliance Issues:** Using unsupported software may lead to non-compliance with industry regulations and standards.

**Software Compatibility:** New applications and updates may not be compatible with Windows 10, affecting your productivity.
